Features Promoting Barrier-Free Computing

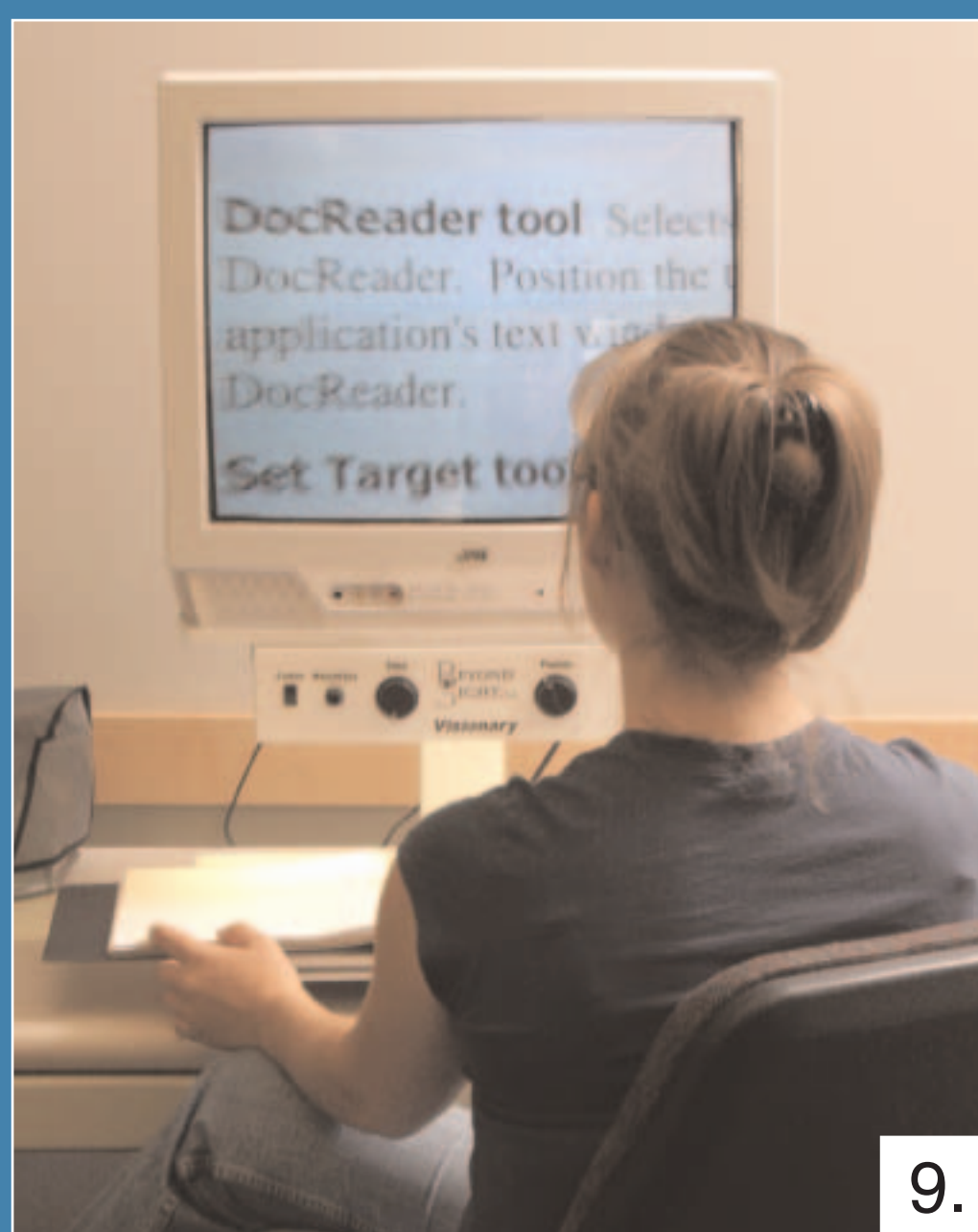
1. Staff trained in accessible information technology (IT) issues
