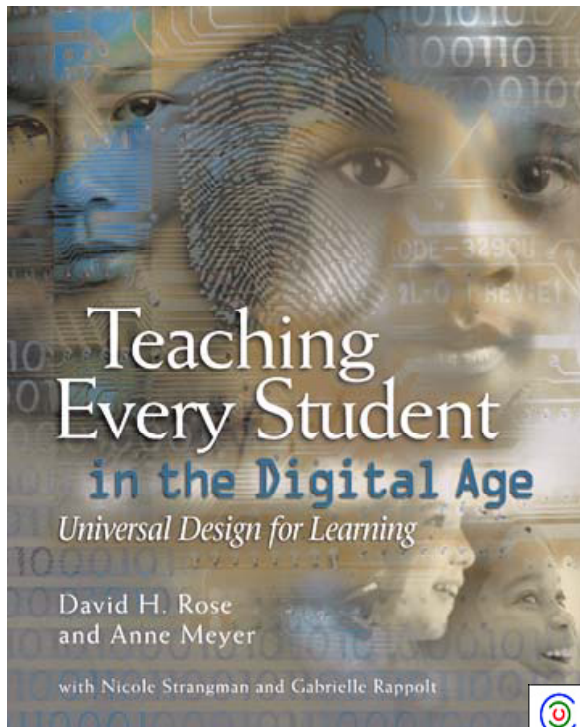

The print book, *Teaching Every Student in the Digital Age: Universal Design for Learning*, addresses the concept of Universal Design for Learning and its practical application in the classroom.

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
